

16.1 BEHAVIOUR INTERVENTION POLICY

POLICY

This policy outlines the procedures, principles, and strategies for addressing challenging behavior and implementing effective behavior interventions for students enrolled in programs offered by SNF Development Center.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all students and staff within the Center.

PRINCIPLES

Positive Reinforcement: Positive behaviors will be reinforced and celebrated, promoting a positive and supportive learning environment.

Individualized Approach: Interventions will be tailored to the individual needs and triggers of each student, respecting their unique abilities and challenges.

Collaboration: Collaboration between teachers, specialists, therapists, and parents/guardians is essential to develop and implement effective behavior intervention plans.

PROCEDURE

Behavior Assessment and Analysis:

- Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA): A comprehensive FBA will be conducted to identify the functions and triggers of challenging behavior.
- Behavior Analysis: The behavior analysis will inform the development of behavior intervention plans (BIPs) to address specific behaviors.

Development and Implementation of BIPs:

- BIP Development: BIPs will be collaboratively developed by the Behavior Intervention Team, including teachers, behavioral therapists, and specialists.
- Strategies: BIPs will include proactive strategies, teaching replacement behaviors, crisis intervention plans, and de-escalation techniques.
- Consent: Parents/guardians will be actively involved in the development and implementation of BIPs, providing informed consent for interventions.

Data Collection and Progress Monitoring:

- Data Collection: Ongoing data collection will be conducted to monitor the effectiveness of interventions and make necessary adjustments.
- Progress Reports: Progress reports will be shared with parents/guardians regularly, highlighting the student's behavioral improvements and challenges.



Crisis Intervention and Safety Protocols:

- De-escalation Techniques: Staff will be trained in de-escalation techniques to safely manage crisis situations and prevent escalation of challenging behavior.
- Emergency Procedures: Clear protocols for emergency situations will be in place, ensuring the safety of students, staff, and others in the vicinity.

Staff Training and Professional Development:
